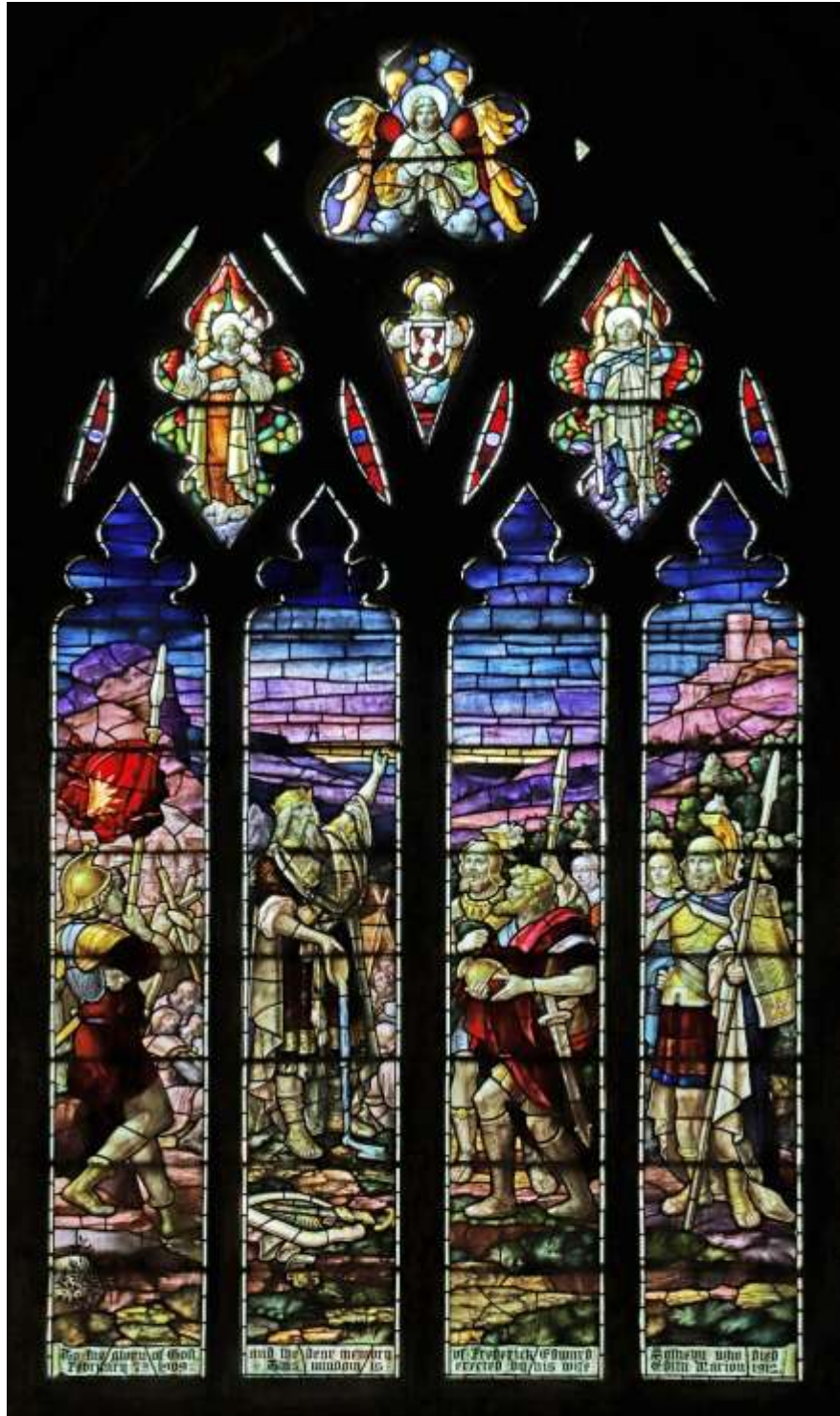

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Introduction

This catalogue has been compiled as an accompaniment to the website covering the life and works of Percy Charles Haydon Bacon, and his firms Percy Bacon & Brothers (1892-1917), and Percy Bacon Limited (1917-1933) (<https://www.celestial-light.org.uk/index.html>). A brief history of the firm can be found [here](#). The website which was started in 2023 is an on-going project to record as many as possible of the extant and lost works of Percy Bacon and Brothers, and Percy Bacon Limited, and publish them in a visual form. It contains significantly more information about the windows than can be accommodated here, including links to other web resources and reference material. Where a church with Percy Bacon work is listed on the website, a link to the record page is provided in this catalogue.

This catalogue is a work in progress, and should be considered a rough draft as there is still much research to be undertaken. It is published here for information only, and although as much care as possible has been taken in researching and recording the entries, some errors will have doubtless crept in. It should therefore be considered "as-is" and not relied on as fact, without the reader first satisfying themselves of the accuracy of the entries. Much of the research has been carried out over the past few years using internet searches, and previously published material, or by viewing the extant works personally. Publications held by the Internet Archive, the British Library News Archive, and Google Books have been particularly useful, as have documents held by various county records offices. Nineteenth and early twentieth century publications such as *The Builder*, *The Building and Engineering Journal*, as well as Pevsner's, *Buildings of England* Guides have provided a wealth of information, though it has to be said that the latter has been found to contain a number of errors which deter one from reliance on the veracity of the entries without further corroboration. Where personal inspection has yet to take place, image websites such as Flickr and Geograph, as well as those of individual churches have provided good evidence of works still in existence.

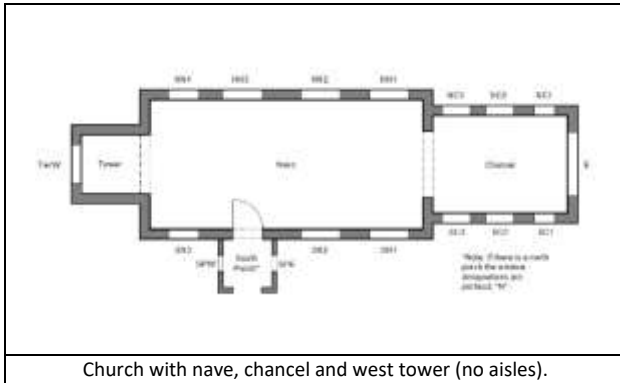
This current draft has been updated to include known works in Scotland and abroad. Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland are listed under "Ireland". An addendum has been added listing places and churches where work of the firm of Percy Bacon & Brothers was carried out, but where the specific nature of the work has not been identified. Where a window or work has been confirmed as being in existence, the word "Extant" has been included in the "Condition" column. If the date of the execution of a work, or the subject matter is still uncertain, or cannot be corroborated, entries will be left blank until verified. A letter "c" in the column adjacent to a recorded date indicates, "circa", and is included if a definitive reference to the year of a window's execution has not been confirmed, but other data such as the date of the dedication provides an indication. A church or work by Percy Bacon which no longer exists is marked with a cross, thus: †

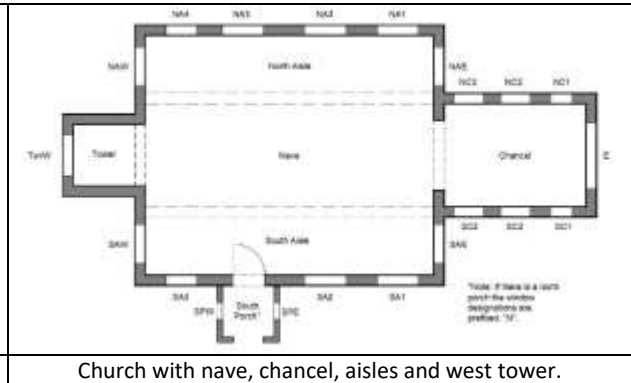

Window position abbreviations

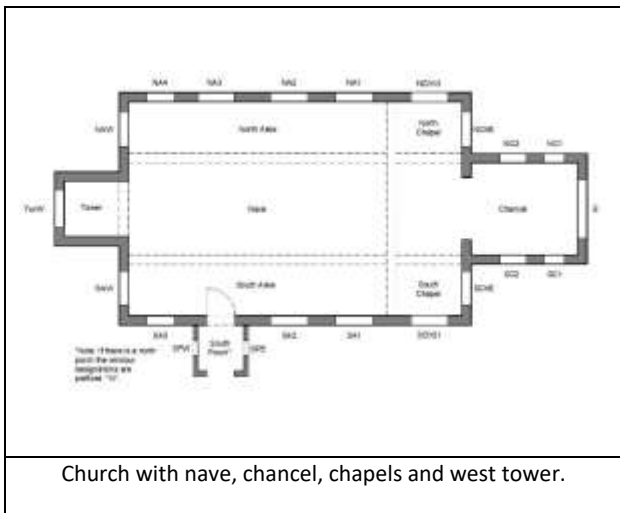
It will generally be clear from the text where a particular window is located in a church, as these are usually written in full. However, where abbreviations are used, the method of describing window locations on this site have been adapted from the nomenclature first used by Birkin Haward in his book, "Nineteenth Century Norfolk Stained Glass". Since its publication in 1984 this method has become common practice. However, Haward's scheme is not comprehensive. Considering the great variety of church plans likely to be encountered, and in an attempt to address this, the plans below provide the reader with a more complete methodology which is intended to be used throughout the site. Each image can be clicked to enlarge. Where clearstories are involved (and there are very few) the windows are generally prefaced "'CIS" or "CIN" for south and north respectively and numbered sequentially from the east.



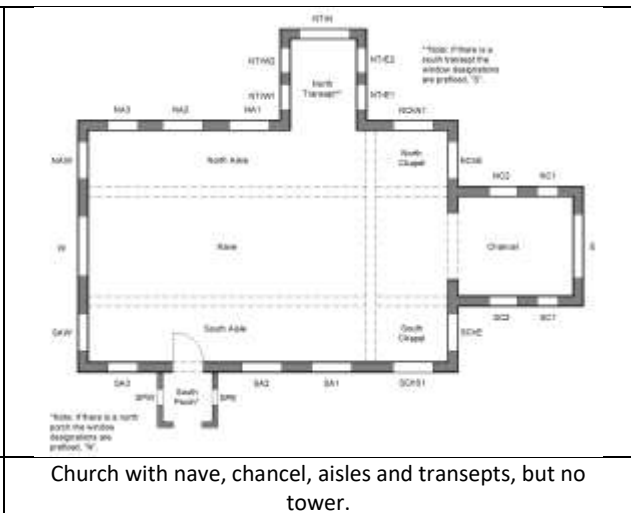
Church with nave, chancel and west tower (no aisles).



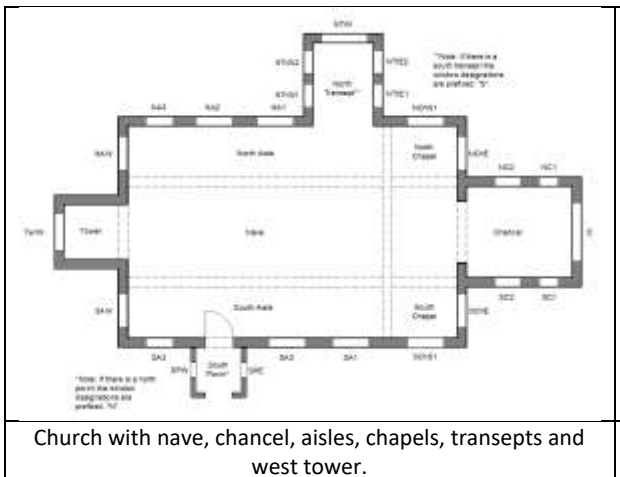
Church with nave, chancel, aisles and west tower.



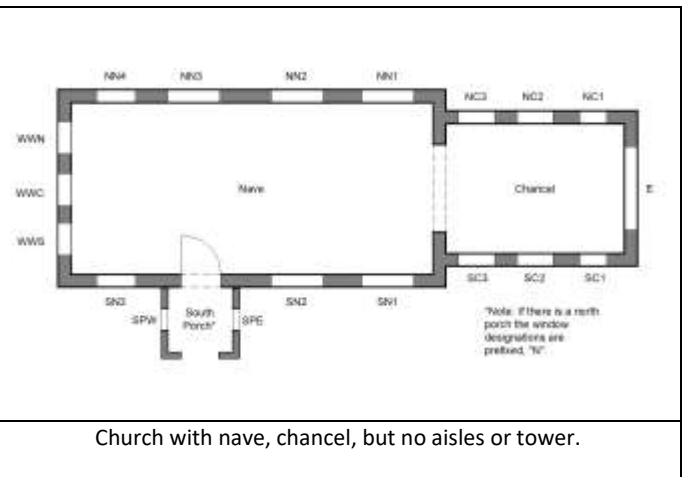
Church with nave, chancel, chapels and west tower.

Addendum

Other Works.

Cambridgeshire Archives holds a "List of Works" by Percy Bacon & Brothers, probably published in the first decade of the 20th century.¹ It is a bi-fold sheet (essentially a flyer), advertising the firm's work as, "Specialists in Church Decoration". The frontispiece records the types of works carried out by the firm: Stained glass windows, paintings, reredos, mural tablets, pulpits, memorial brasses, screens, lecterns etc. It lists over 200 place names in the UK and abroad, sometimes mentioning the specific church where work had been carried out, but not the type of work. About 110 of these are already recorded in this Corpus (including lost works), but that leaves half which are not. That half is listed here as they appear in the List of Works. In most of the churches or place names listed here, the exact work has not been established. "†" indicates that the church no longer exists with date of demolition if known. Due to the numbers involved London is listed in a separate column.
